- Established 2019 after blatant attacks on merchant vessels attributed to state actors
- Mission: Form an international coalition, deter and expose state-sponsored malign activity, reassure partners and merchant industry
- Objective: Restore and maintain international rules-based order; freedom of navigation; free-flow of commerce
- Relevance
- 42,000 ships and 20% of world's energy supply transit Strait of Hormuz annually
- 21 Million barrels of oil leave the Gulf every day
- \$685 Billion worth of oil transits through Strait of Hormuz annually
