### 1. Blockade Activity

JMIC is sharing information on the following page for the awareness of owners, operators, and Mariners. Specifically, it details **the end of the U.S. blockade of Iranian ports and coastline**.

The maritime security threat level in the Arabian Gulf, Strait of Hormuz, and Gulf of Oman was reduced to **SUBSTANTIAL** following the announced agreement on the United States – Iran Memorandum of Understanding, and for the reasons detailed in Update 059 to JMIC# 001-26 (June 16, 2026) pertaining to the Arabian Gulf, Strait of Hormuz, and Gulf of Oman.
