

ATTACK		Yemen. Master initially reported an explosion in close proximity to the
		vessel. Subsequently, the Master has reported a 2nd explosion in the air
		and in close proximity to the vessel. Master reports evidence of shrapnel
		and damage to paintwork. The vessel and crew are reported to be safe
		and proceeding to the next port of call.

034	1746UTC 19 Feb 24	UKMTO has received a report of 2 Uncrewed Aerial Systems (UAS) following a
SUSPICIOUS		merchant vessel for approximately 30 minutes. The UAS were assessed to be at
APPROACH		a height of 100m above the vessel and are now reported to have cleared the
		area. Vessel and crew are safe. Authorities continue to investigate. Vessels are
		advised to transit with caution and report any suspicious activity to UKMTO.
