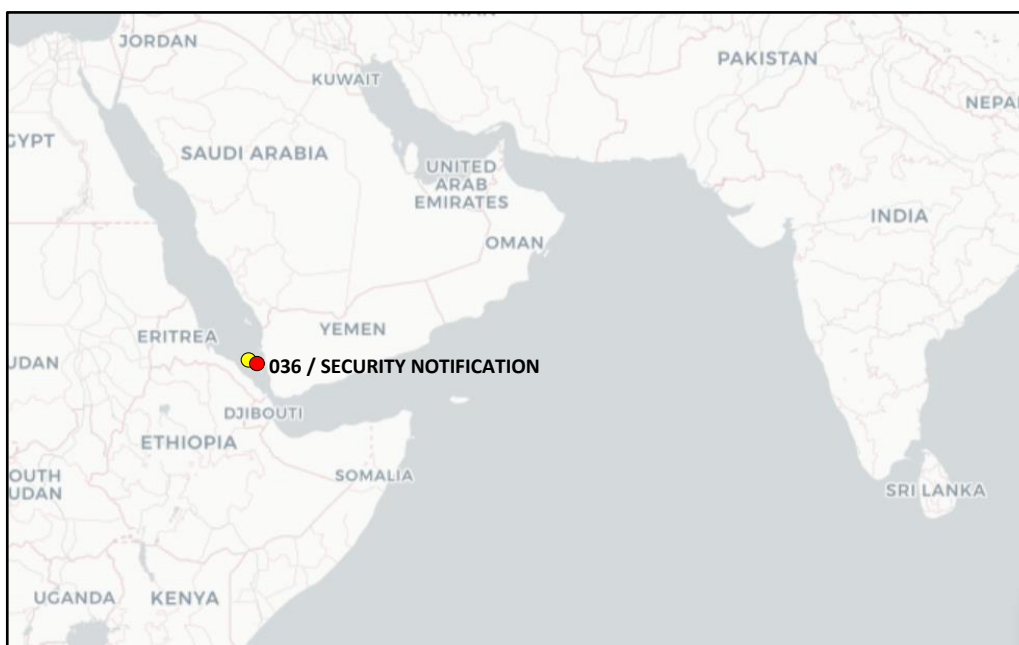

Masters are requested to report any UAS activity to UKMTO and are advised to follow industry guidance on loitering munitions: Loitering Munitions – The Threat to Merchant Ships (ocimf.org) The security notification is valid for a 72-hour period from time stated. 036 ATTACK	0027UTC Feb 24	UKMTO has received time late reports of an explosion and a flash sighted in the Southern Red Sea 40NM to the west of Al Hudaydah, Yemen.
