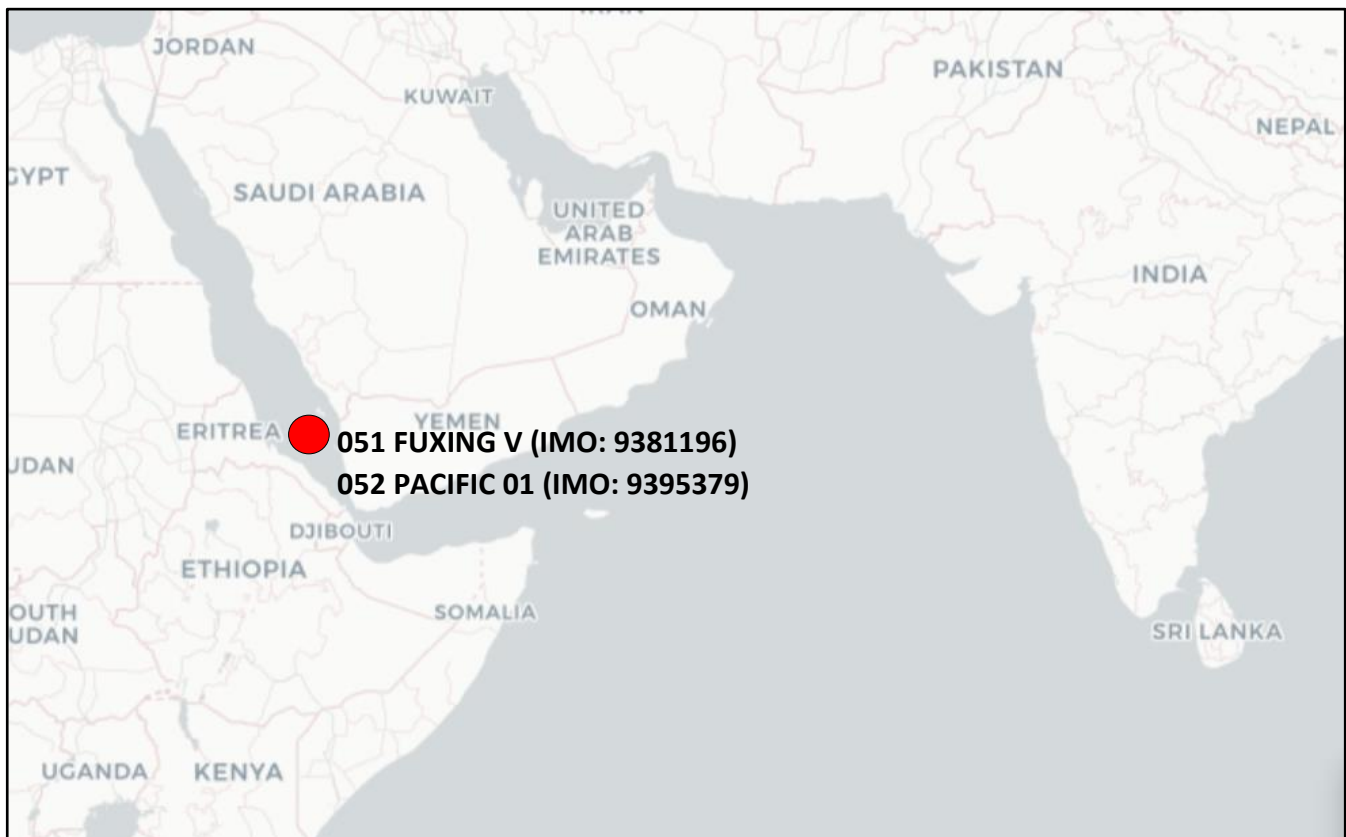

Update 001: The Master reported two missiles flying over the vessel and heard two loud blasts in the distance. The vessel reports no damage and the crew are reported safe, the vessel is proceeding to its next port of call. Authorities are investigating. INCIDENT 052 ATTACK MV PACIFIC 01 (IMO: 9395379)	15 0205 UTC Mar 24	UKMTO has received a report of an incident 76NM west of Al Hudaydah, Yemen. Update 001: A merchant vessel has reported that they have been struck by a missile and the vessel has sustained some damage. The crew are reported safe and the vessel is proceeding to its next port of call. ukmto-warning-incident-052-attack-update-001.pdf Update 002: Following a daylight inspection of the vessel the Master has reported that the vessel has not been hit and not received any damage. The crew are reported safe and the vessel is proceeding to its next port of call. Authorities continue to monitor.
