063		<ul> <li>UKMTO received a report of an incident 50NM northeast of Fujairah, United Arab Emirates. The Portuguese flagged container vessel MSC ARIES which had been transiting with AIS switched off, in position of 25° 43′ 00″N - 056° 41′ 00″ E and whilst transiting outbound of the Straight of Hormuz was reported to have been boarded by unknown personnel. The personnel were reported to have been inserted onto the MSC ARIES by helicopter. It was subsequently confirmed that the MSC ARIES had been seized by regional authorities, had altered course northbound into Iranian Territorial waters and all communication with the vessel had ceased.
