# **Command Overview**

**INCIDENT DISPOSITION** 

1. Weather conditions appear to be improving in the Indian Ocean indicating signs that the SW Monsoon is abating. During the inter-monsoon (or transition) period small boat activity increases as regional trade and fishing activity picks up. As the inter-monsoon period approaches, masters are reminded of the need to remain vigilant and ship operators/charterers are strongly recommended to apply BMP throughout the High Risk Area, continue registering with MSCHOA and report to UKMTO.

2. On 21 Aug 16 UKMTO personnel visited the tanker MT Smyrni in Jebel Ali to update the master and crew on regional maritime security issues. MT Smyrni was the last merchant vessel to be hijacked in the Indian Ocean having been taken on 11 May 12 and released by her armed pirate captors on <u>10 Mar 13</u>.
