

# **Command Overview**

1. This week's main chart illustrates a two monthly roundup of 'low level' sightings reported in the Eastern IRTC. Although probing approaches by pirate gangs can never be ruled out it would appear that these sightings are normal Pattern of Life (POL) and can be attributed to recent improved weather conditions and sea state in the area which is allowing Yemeni fishing boats to transit to the Socotra fishing grounds. The chart below shows in more detail, POL reports received from the area this week.



- 2. Improved Governance in Somalia has been a significant contributory factor in the suppression of pirate related crime off the coast of Somali (a), however some Somali pirates may be diversifying their activity by providing protection to foreign vessels fishing illegally within Somali
