Command Overview

1. One Advisory released this week (001/May/2016).

2. This week's Advisory was reported from a position where groups of fishermen are known to transit or operate. It is not uncommon for large numbers of skiffs to work together, their behaviour can often look random or erratic as they chase pods of dolphins or shoals of fish. The NATO Shipping Centre web-site provides additional information on <u>fishing in the High</u> <u>Risk Area</u>. Fishermen are also known to follow in the wake of vessels as it disturbs the water bringing nutrients to the surface which attracts the fish.

3. In the UK's Daily Mail this week, the shadow Defence Secretary, Emily Thornberry claims that 'a sharp reduction in pirate attacks off Somalia is "inconvertible proof" that European Union membership helps Britain achieve its security priorities'. Her comments came following a recent visit to the home of the EU's Counter Piracy Mission, Op Atalanta in Northwood, UK (a). In related news the EU has appointed Brig Robert Magowan CBE RM as operation commander for the EU Naval Force Somalia – EU NAVFOR Operation Atalanta taking over from MGen Martin Smith MBE (d). 4. Category: Suspicious Approach

Description: On 16 May 2016 at 0512 UTC in position 14 45.0N 050 58.0E, an MV reported that five skiff's approached to 0.5 cables. Skiffs were black/brown in colour with between 3 to 5 POB, ladders were sighted. MV's security team fired warning shots and MV took evasive action. Skiffs then opened between 1 and 2.5 nm.
