INCIDENT DISPOSITION

IN THIS ISSUE

Command Overview

- 1. UKMTO have released two Warnings and three Advisory Notices this week (see page 3).
- 2. OS35 was hijacked on 08 Apr 17, Ref WARNING NOTICE 001/APR/ 2017. The ship's company managed to secure themselves within a citadel and establish communications. This action allowed the military freedom of manoeuvre to board and secure the vessel. The crew are all safe with no reported injuries. There was a rapid response by the military community with close cooperation between navies operating independently and those operating under EUNAVFOR and CMF.
- 3. Safe Sino was reported as having coming under attack on 14 Apr 17, Ref WARNING NOTICE 002/APR/ 2017. Subsequent investigations indicates that this would appear to be a local dispute with Yemen authorities from the port of Nishtun. Vessel and crew are safe.
- 4. UKMTO have been advised that Al Kausar, which was reported as having been hijacked on 01 Apr 17, Ref ADVISORY NOTICE 001/APR/ 2017, has been released and that all crew are now safe.
- 5. Due to the recent increase in incidents all shipping transiting the area should remain vigilant. As previously advised by UKMTO, it is highly recommended to fully follow the guidance given in Best Management Practices for Protection against

- Somalia Based Piracy 4 (BMP4), copy at the following link http://bit.ly/2ifzmAu
- 6. In addition to the issuing of Warnings and Advisories UKMTO may endeavour to contact merchant shipping in the area of an incident. To ensure that records are maintained up to date it is requested that shipping adhere to the reporting format and guidelines detailed within BMP4.

WARNINGS

001/APR/2017

Description: At 1310 UKMTO received a report from a vessel under ATTACK and possibly BOARDED in position 1402.9N 05140.0E Co. 255 Sp 11 close to Point 'B' in the IRTC. Further details will follow, UKMTO are investigating. Vessels transiting the area are advised to exercise extreme caution.

001/APR/2017 - Update 001

Description: At 1310 UTC, UKMTO received a phone call from the Master of a vessel which had been ATTACKED and BOARDED. Vessel currently in position 1402.08N 05137.06E drifting, close to Point 'B' in the IRTC. Situation is ongoing. Further details will follow when known. All vessels to keep clear. Vessels transiting the area are advised to exercise extreme caution.

002/APR/2017

Description: At 0652 UTC, UKMTO received a confirmed report that a vessel was under ATTACK and shots have been fired towards MV in position 1555.5N 05220.7E. Further details will follow, UKMTO are investigating. Vessels transiting the area are advised to exercise extreme caution.

ADVISORIES

003PR/2017

Category: Attack - Boarding

Description: On 08 April at 1310 UTC in position 1402.09N 05140.00E, an MV was approached by a skiff with pirates which boarded the vessel, the Master and crew stopped the engines and located to the Citadel. The MV was left drifting. On 09 April at 0432 UTC in position 14-02.5N 051-

37.9E, the vessel is now back under control of the Company and Master. The MV is underway to next Port of Call and under Escort.

004/APR/2017

Category: Suspicious Approach


Description: On 09 April at 0315 UTC in position 1420N 05311E, an MV reported a vessel closed to a distance of 1nm from their bow with additional four skiffs seen on their starboard beam at a distance of 0.5nm. Four POBs sighted on each skiff with weapons. AST showed presence and the vessels moved away. Vessel is SAFE.

ADVISORIES

005/APR/2017

Category: Attack

Description: Ref Warning 002 APR 17. Vessel and crew are now SAFE. MV was approached in position 1555.8N 05220.7E by a small boat with 6-7 armed POB and attempted to board MV several times with no success. Shots were fired towards MV and then small boat departed area, no casualties or damage was observed.
