

IN THIS ISSUE Command Overview

This week UKMTO have issued no Advisories and no Warnings.

1. Please note that the date of the next Shared Awareness and De-confliction conference (SHADE) has moved to 20 – 21 Nov 18 and will take place in Bahrain. Therefore the UKMTO Maritime Information Exchange Vessel Operators Meeting (MIEVOM) will now be on 29 Nov 18 in Dubai. A calling notice for the MIEVOM will be issued in Sept 18.

2. Reported sightings of small boat activity remain low as the SW monsoon continues to affect the region. Winds in excess of 30 mph with waves up to 5 mtrs impacts fishing and other pattern of life activity in the Gulf of Aden.

3. From 19 Aug 18, the UKMTO Weekly Report will be released on a Sunday.
