Command Overview

This week UKMTO has issued no Advisories and no Warnings.

1. The Maritime Shipping Industry's publication 'Best Management Practises to Deter Piracy and Enhance Maritime Security in the Red Sea, Gulf of Aden, Indian Ocean and Arabian Sea' (BMP5), was released this week. Superseding BMP4, BMP5 includes additional guidance on how to best mitigate against a broader range of maritime threat including piracy, conflict spill over into the maritime domain and terrorism. Hard copies of BMP5 will be available soon.

2. In addition to BMP5, an association of Shipping Industry organizations simultaneously launched a new Maritime Global Security website including their new publication the 'Global Counter Piracy Guidance for Companies, Masters and Seafarers' which covers the threat to shipping worldwide.

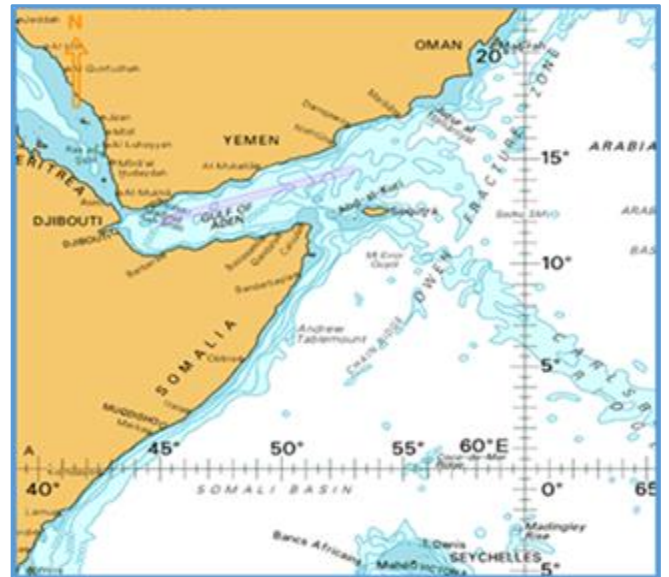
