Description: On 22 July 2018 at 1422UTC a MV in position 01 06.32N 044 02.0E in vicinity of Baraawe reported being under attack. Attack has now ceased. The MV is now safe and in the port of Baraawe. Vessels transiting the area are advised to exercise extreme caution.
