

- 1. In accordance with previously promulgated guidance by Combined Maritime Forces (CMF), vessels should consider transiting the region via the Maritime Security Transit Corridor (MSTC) exiting the TSS to the West of the Hanish Islands. Follow link for details https://bit.ly/3iNoeL9.
- 2. Military exercises within the Voluntary Reporting Area (VRA) may involve the use of drones. Masters are encouraged to report suspicious/irregular activity to UKMTO, including any sightings of drones.
- 3. Thursday 10 June Another reminder to 'save the date' for the upcoming Maritime Information Exchange Vessel Operators' Meeting (MIEVOM). It is still expected to run as a hybrid event being face to face but with the ability to join virtually. Further details, including the calling notice will be promulgated shortly.
- 4. EUNAVOR held a Change of Command ceremony in Rota on 21 April with Vice Admiral José María Nuñez Torrente from the Spanish Navy taking command and continuing to implement their increased Operation ATALANTA mandate, extended until December 2022. Media article e. refers.
