### 1. Republic of Korea Warship rescues civilian mariners in Gulf of Aden

On 26 June 2022 a naval vessel from the Republic of Korea rescued four civilian mariners from the United Kingdom who were adrift aboard a sailing vessel after the engine failed while transiting the Gulf of Aden. Republic of Korea Navy destroyer Dae Jo Yeong (DD 977) responded after Combined Maritime Forces (CMF), an international partnership headquartered in Bahrain, was notified of a distress call from the stranded mariners.

### 2. International Chamber of Shipping Board appoints Emanuele Grimaldi as Chairman

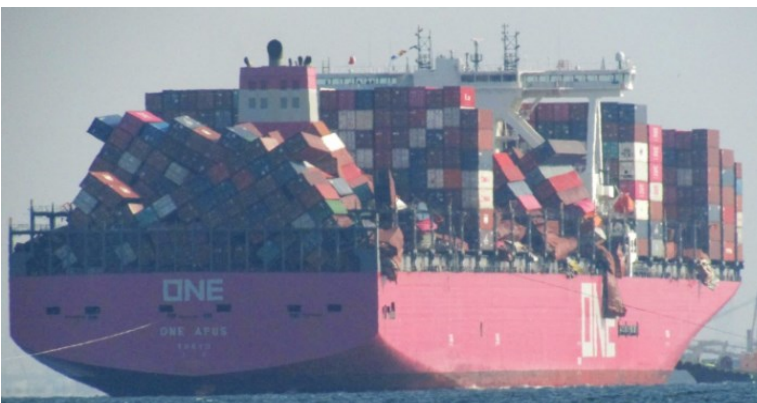
The board of the [International Chamber of Shipping](#) (ICS) has appointed Emanuele Grimaldi, President and Managing Director of Grimaldi Euromed SpA, as Chairman of the Board. The ICS is one of the biggest collective voices in maritime, representing 80% of the world's merchant fleet. It's had consultative status at the UN International Maritime Organization since 1961, where it works towards regulation of shipping at an international level.

### 3. Survey shows worrying increase in number of containers lost at sea

The number of shipping containers lost at sea has risen significantly during the pandemic thanks to an "unusually high" number of incidents particularly in the winter of 2020-21, the World Shipping Council said in its latest Containers Lost at Sea report. The winter of 2020-21 saw a huge spike in the number of weather-related incidents, bringing average losses for the two-year period (2020-2021) to 3,113 containers, compared to 779 in the previous period (2017-2019).
