### 2. Iran to release crew of Greek tankers

Iran is to release the crews of two Greek tankers it seized in May, a Greek merchant marine group said Sunday 11 September 2022. Iran agreed to the replacement during a recent visit by a Greek delegation, the Greek Union of Merchant Marine Sailors said on its website. The stranded crew members “*will immediately return to their countries of origin*” starting as soon as Monday, according to the group.
