#### • AU, EU train Somali marine officers to enhance coastline security.

The African Union (AU) Transition Mission in Somalia (ATMIS) and the European Union Capacity Building Mission in Somalia (EUCAP Somalia) have wrapped up a two-week specialized training on maritime security as part of ongoing efforts to protect the country's long coastline. The AU mission said in a statement issued on Thursday evening in the Somali capital of Mogadishu that 15 Somali Navy and Coast Guard (SNCG) officers took part in the training on general seamanship, basic safety, boat maintenance, radio communications, maritime law, and first aid skills.

#### • First Third of Crude Oil Successfully Transferred from FSO Safer.

The oil transfer from the derelict FSO Safer off the coast of Yemen is proceeding well according to updates from the United Nations and Boskalis. The team from SMIT Salvage began the ship-to-ship transfer at the beginning of last week and they are now reporting that more than a third of the crude oil has been transferred without incident.
