001/Dec/2023	<u>Incident</u>	UKTMO received a report of Uncrewed Aerial Systems (UAS) activity including an explosion 7nm away from the reporting vessel in the vicinity of the Bab el Mandeb (BAM). Vessel and crew are safe.
002/Dec/2023	<u>Incident</u>	UKTMO received a report of an attack by UAS in the vicinity of the BAM in position 13 25N 042 40E. All crew except master and one took shelter in the citadel. Coalition forces assisted and the vessel departed the area. Vessel and crew are safe.
003/Dec/2023	<u>Incident</u> Update 001	UKTMO received reports of attacks by UAS in the vicinity of BAM, po- sition 15 16E 041 42E. A vessel was hailed by a claimed Yemeni au- thority and ordered the vessel to change course or be fired upon. The vessel reported being fired upon. The vessel reported that there were no casualties on board and subsequently vacated the area. Vessel and crew are safe.

001/Dec/2023	<u>Irregular Activity</u>	UKMTO was made aware of an entity declaring itself to be the Yemeni authorities ordering a vessel to alter course towards Yemeni waters and threatening the vessel that it would be in danger of attack if it failed to comply. Vessel and crew are safe.
002/Dec2023	<u>Incident</u>	UKMTO received a report of an incident involving a UAS hovering in the vicinity of position 14 25N 042 12E, circa 48nm West of port Hodei- dah, Yemen. The vessel then reported that a coalition warship shot down the earlier reported drone. Vessel and crew are safe.
