007Dec/2023	<u>Incident</u> <u>Update 001</u>	UKMTO received a report of an explosion sighted 50 metres off the reporting ves- sel's port quarter whilst transiting the BAM. Nothing further of significance reported.		
008/Dec/2023	<u>Incident</u> <u>Update 001</u> <u>Update 002</u> <u>Update 003</u>	UKMTO received a report of a distress call heard over VHF of a vessel being boarded by unknown persons in the vicinity of 700NM East of Bossaso, Somalia. The vessel was seized by unauthorised persons and taken towards Somalia. The crew are reported as safe on board. Coalition warships closely monitor the vessel.		
009/Dec/2023	<u>Incident</u> Update 001	UKMTO received a report of a small white craft with a black top, and 10 unidenti- fied POB, in the vicinity of 50NM North of port Mokha, Yemen. They declared themselves to be Yemeni authorities and ordered the reporting vessel to alter course towards Yemen. However, the reporting vessel continued passage and was subsequently attacked, struck on the starboard side and an explosion report- ed. A fire was extinguished and the vessel cleared the area without casualties, to the NPOC.		
010/Dec/2023	<u>Incident</u> <u>Update 001</u>	As per Warning 009/Dec/23 above.		
011/Dec/2023	Incident	UKMTO received a report from a vessel in the vicinity of the BAM, 30NM South West of port Mokha, Yemen. Although the reporting vessel had not heard any warnings, it had been struck on the starboard side resulting in an explosion. A fire was extinguished without casualties. Reporting vessel proceeded to the NPOC.		
012/Dec/2023	Incident	UKMTO received a report of a water explosion in the vicinity of the BAM, 30NM South of port Mokha, Yemen. The Master reported the event 2NM off the vessel's port quarter before clearing the area and proceeded to her NPOC.		
013/Dec/2023	<u>Incident</u> Update 001	UKMTO received a report of an attack in the vicinity 30NM North West of Mokha port, Yemen. The vessel had been struck with an explosion on her port side, near a water tank and without causing a fire. A further attack saw an airborne object splashing into the water approximately 1NM off the port bow. No casualties were reported, the vessel cleared the area and proceeded to the NPOC.		
014/Dec/2023	<u>Incident</u> Update 001	UKMTO received a report of a vessel approached by one small craft with several armed POB in the vicinity of 24NM South East Of Mokha Port, Yemen. An embarked AST fired shots to warn-off the small craft and it altered away. Later, the reporting vessel was circled 4 times by 2 x UAS just South of the BAM. The UAS was reported to be about a metre long with a flashing red light. It came as close as 50 metres and continued to circle the ship for between 30 and 40 minutes, before departing the area. The vessel reported 7 UAS approaches in total before itself clearing the area and proceeded to NPOC without further incident.

015/Dec/2023	<u>Incident</u> <u>Update 001</u>	UKMTO received a report of 5 small boats containing armed personnel approaching the vessel in the vicinity 63NM North West Of Djibouti. The small boats harassed the vessel as it took evasive manoeuvres, closing to less than a mile. Intervention by coalition forces, including an aircraft likely deterred anything more. The vessel cleared the area, with all crew safe and proceeded to NPOC.				
016/Dec/2023	<u>Incident</u> <u>Update 001</u> <u>Update 002</u>	UKMTO received a report of a vessel approached by 4 small boats, 4 or 5 POB in each, in the vicinity of 80NM NorthEast of Djibouti. The small boats were blue/grey in colour. One small boat paralleled the vessel's course at 0.5NM before breaking away. The Master reported that no hailing was heard or weapons sighted.				
Advisory 007/Dec/2023	Security Notification	UKMTO received a report of a UAS in the vicinity of 84NM East of Dji- bouti. The Master reported 2 x UAS circling the vessel several times at a distance of 50 metres before disappearing. The reporting vessel cleared the area with nothing further of significance to report.
