1. Sea power in focus again in Middle East amid joint drills, defense exhibitions

From the Eastern Mediterranean to the Red Sea and the Gulf of Oman, there is an increased focus on naval issues such as securing seaways and defending against threats. The United Arab Emirates is hosting important defense exhibitions in the coming week. One of them is IDEX and, held alongside it, the important naval exhibition called NAVDEX. Vessels are coming from all around the world, including the UK, India, China, Bahrain, Italy and local vessels from the UAE. Some 60 countries are also displaying defense technology
