The team at UKMTO (Dubai) was delighted to host Commodore Ben Aldous Royal Navy, Commander of the Coalition Task Force SENTINEL on Monday 20 March for an exchange of updates on Maritime Security matters. Commodore Aldous and two of his International Maritime Security Construct (IMSC) colleagues are currently conducting stakeholder engagement within the UAE. Following on from UKMTO (Dubai), the IMSC team moved on to meet with the Commander of French forces in the Middle East, Rear Admiral Slaars French Navy in Abu Dhabi as well as the new Commander at the European Maritime Awareness in the Straits of Hormuz (EMASoH), Rear Admiral Flamant Belgian Navy. Cdre Aldous's round-robin tour of regional engagement will also take up a number of maritime industry contacts in the UAE, before returning to Bahrain.
