Boskalis announced recently that, through its subsidiary SMIT Salvage, the company reached an agreement with the United Nations Development Program (UNDP) for oil removal from the FSO Safer moored off Yemen's Red Sea coast.

• Guards on famed yacht open fire off Yemen; 1 reported killed.

Armed private guards aboard a famous yacht once owned by the late Welsh actor Richard Burton fired on approaching ships on Friday in the Gulf of Aden, off the coast of Yemen, in an intense gunfight. The authorities said the guards mistakenly opened fire on Yemeni Coast Guard members but the ship's manager insisted they shot at pirates.
