003/Nov/2023	<u>Warning</u> <u>Update 1</u> <u>Update 2</u>	UKMTO received third party reports of an attack and boarding by un- known and unauthorised personnel, transmitted over VHF. Vessel was not transmitting AIS and comms were lost. Vessel boarded by five uni- dentified, unauthorised and armed persons. Crew believed to have sheltered in the citadel whilst naval vessels responded to a distress call. The unauthorised personnel disembarked in a small craft but were subsequently detained. The crew of the vessel are reported to be safe. Mariners should remain vigilant, proceed with caution and follow best management practices. All vessels are requested to submit voluntary reports to UKMTO whilst transiting the VRA in accordance with BMP5.
