

Aden Anchorage - Reported Malign Activity

UKMTO has been made aware of recent reporting between the Government of Yemen and the United Nations Verification and Inspection Mechanism for Yemen (UNVIM), with respect to a vessel operating in the vicinity of the Aden anchorage. It is reported that an LPG Tanker was contacted through VHF radio by an entity that claimed to be UNVIM. The vessel was directed by the impersonator to divert from Aden and move to Hodeidah. Confused by the circumstances, the ship subsequently sought external direction and guidance. It is also reported that the Aden Harbour Master had received communication from a third party claiming to be responsible.

It is understood that UNVIM continue to monitor events in the Aden anchorage closely. In the meantime all vessels operating in the area should remain particularly vigilant to behaviours of this nature and seek further guidance, where appropriate. Any other vessels experiencing anomalies of this nature are requested to report their concerns to UNVIM as well as UKMTO in line with the industry guidance issued in BMP 5.
