Combined Task Force 151 (CTF 151) (Philippines). The UKMTO (Dubai) team was delighted to host Captain Mateo Carido Philippines Navy (PN) supported by his Staff Lieutenant Commander Eduard Pablico PN, Lieutenant Brylle Barley PN and Lieutenant Francis Carl Ramos PN on the occasion of a routine working visit to the Dubai office for briefings on 27 September. The Philippines is commanding the Counter-Piracy Task Force until January 2024 when they will handover to a Brazilian command team. With routine counter-piracy warship and aircraft patrols ongoing; CTF 151 intends to conduct focussed anti-piracy operations in late November, with more detail to be announced in due course.
