061 062	Attack	<p>061452UTC Apr 24 - HOPE ISLAND. IMO: 9263320.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> UKMTO received reports of an incident 60 nautical miles southwest of Al Hudaydah, Yemen. The Master of the Marshall Islands flagged container vessel, HOPE ISLAND, which was travelling in a southbound direction of the Red Sea, reported that there had been three separate missile launches in the vicinity of the vessel while they were transiting the Red Sea, Bab el Mendeb and Gulf of Aden, between 061453UTC Apr 24 and 070503UTC Apr 24. The vessel had departed its previous port with AIS switched on, but when HOPE ISLAND neared the threat area of 16° 00' 00"N - 047° 00' 00" E, the ship had switched AIS off, following JMIC guidance. Prior to the missile launches there was UAV activity in the vicinity of the vessel on 06 Apr 24 at 1135 UTC. Subsequently, there were missile launches reported at 1452 UTC on 06 Apr, 2359 UTC on 06 2 Apr, and 0503 UTC on 07 Apr. The HOPE ISLAND reported that there had been no damage, and, that the crew was safe. The HOPE ISLAND proceeded to her next port of call without further incident.
