064	<a href="#">Attack</a>	<p><b>240900UTC Apr 24 - MAERSK YORKTOWN. IMO: 9289192.</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>UKMTO received a report of an incident circa 72 nautical miles east southeast of the port of Djibouti. The master of the USA-flagged cargo vessel, MAERSK YORKTOWN, which at the time was in the vicinity of position 11° 18' 00" N - 044° 18' 00" E, reported an explosion in the water between three and five cables astern of the vessel. Having mustered the crew in the citadel, the vessel proceeded to the south to clear the area. The MAERSK YORKTOWN and crew were reported to be safe as it proceeded to the next port of call without further incident.</li> <li>For further details on this incident see: <a href="#">CMF-JMIC InfoNote</a></li> </ul>
065	<a href="#">Attack</a>	<p><b>250715UTC Apr 24 - MSC DARWIN VI. IMO: 9200689.</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>UKMTO received a report of an incident circa 15 nautical miles southwest of Aden, Yemen. The Master of the Liberian-flagged container vessel MSC DARWIN VI, which was in the vicinity of position 13° 41' 00" N - 044° 05' 00" E, reported hearing a loud bang and a splash with smoke seen coming from the sea, between three and four cables away from MSC DARWIN VI. No damage was sustained whilst the vessel and crew were reported to be safe. ### CMF - Combined Task Force 151 (CTF151) - Counter - Piracy (CP)

Focused Operation “Mare Liberum IV” will run from 28 Apr 24 to 02 May 24. The aim of this operation is to focus CP efforts in the deterrence of illicit, non-state use of the high seas, develop regional leadership capacity and reassure the international community, to maintain enduring maritime security within the CTF 151 area of responsibility, and, uphold rules based order.
