Incident 026	Attack Update 001	At 09:56 UTC on Thursday 01 February, UKMTO received a report of an incident in the vicinity of a position circa 57 nautical miles West of Al Hudaydah, Yemen. The master oberved what he believed to be "a missile" and witnessed the object cause a large explosion in the water. Without a specific range being given to UKMTO, the explosion was reported to have occurred a distance off the vessel's starboard side. A French Navy vessel was close by, as were three other merchant vessels headed in the same direction. Following-on from the water explosion, the reporting vessel and its crew were confirmed to be safe, as it cleared the area at maximum speed initially, and then subsequently on to its next port of call, without further incident.
