023/Dec/2023	<u>Incident</u> <u>Update 001</u> <u>Update 002</u>	UKMTO received a report of an incident approximately 55NM South West of Al Hudaydah, Yemen. The master reported a loud bang accompanied by a flash on the port bow of the vessel. Several more explosions were also sighted in the vicini- ty of Al Hudaydah by the master. It was subsequently reported that there was no damage to the vessel, which then proceeded to the next port of call. The master contacted coalition forces on VHF at the time, who monitored the situation through- out. The crew remained safe throughout.		
024/Dec/2023	<u>Incident</u> Update 001	UKMTO received a report of an attack 60NM North West of Al Hudaydah, Yemen. The master reported being attacked by 3 small boats on his Port side, shots were exchanged. All crew were accounted for without any casualties. Coalition forces assisted at the time, and the small boats departed. After an exchange of fire with US military helicopters, US authorities reported that a number of small vessels were engaged, with three destroyed. The master confirmed the vessel and crew were safe as the vessel exited the area, the reporting vessel continued on its voy- age to the next port of call.		
001/Jan/2024	<u>Incident</u> <u>Update 001</u>	UKMTO received reports of up to three explosions between one and five NM from a merchant vessel in the Bab El Mandeb, 33NM East of Assab, Eritrea. The mas- ter reported no damage to the reporting vessel and crew were reported as safe, with the vessel proceeding safely to its next port of call
