002/Jan/2024	Boarding Update 001 Update 002 Update 003	UKMTO received a report of an incident 460NM east of Eyl, Somalia. It was reported that 5 to 6 unauthorised armed persons boarded a merchant vessel. The Master reported that the crew mustered in the Citadel. Military forces boarded the vessel and conducted a thorough search, no unauthorised persons were found onboard, all crew were reported safe and accounted for. The vessel proceeded out of the area and on to its next port of call.		
003/Jan/2024	<u>Suspicious</u> Approach Update 001	UKMTO received a report of 6 small craft approaching a merchant vessel to within 1NM, approximately 50NM South East of Mocha, Yemen. No weapons were sighted and Coalition Forces assisted. The small craft cleared the area, the vessel and crew were reported safe. Authorities continued to investigate as the vessel proceeded to its next port of call.		
004/Jan/2024	<u>Suspicious</u> <u>Approach</u> <u>Update 001</u>	UKMTO received a report of 2 small craft with a green hull approaching a merchant vessel to within 0.5NM-1NM, approximately 50NM South East of Al Mukha, Yemen. No weapons were sighted, vessel and crew reported safe. Authorities continued to investigate as the vessel proceeded to its next port of call.		
005/Jan/2024	<u>Incident</u> <u>Update 001 -</u> <u>Irregular</u> <u>Activity</u>	UKMTO received a report of incidents approximately 50NM West of Al Hudaydah. There were multiple reports of Uncrewed Aerial Systems (UAS) activity. Coalition forces responded, with no injuries or any damage to any vessels reported. All ves- sels in the vicinity of the Irregular Activity proceeded onto their next ports of call.
