058	Attack	<p>231435UTC Mar 24 - HUANG PU. IMO: 9402469.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> UKMTO was made aware of an incident in the vicinity of 13° 20' 02"N - 042° 50' 00" E approximately 23 nautical miles west of Mukha, Yemen. The Panama flagged crude oil tanker HUANG PU was on a southbound transit at the time with her AIS switched on. The vessel called a 'MAYDAY' and reported that the vessel had been struck on the port side by an unidentified projectile, which had resulted in a one and a half metres wide hole and started a fire onboard. The fire was successfully extinguished by the crew with no injuries reported. The HUANG PU and crew were reported safe and the vessel continued to the next port of call without further incident or requirement for assistance.
