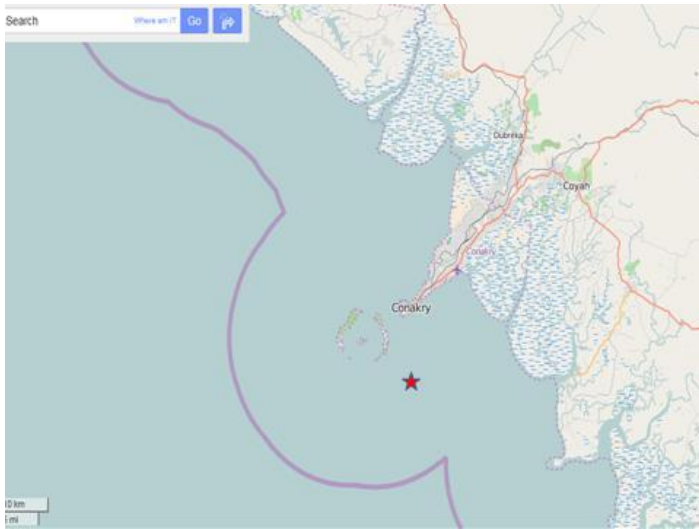

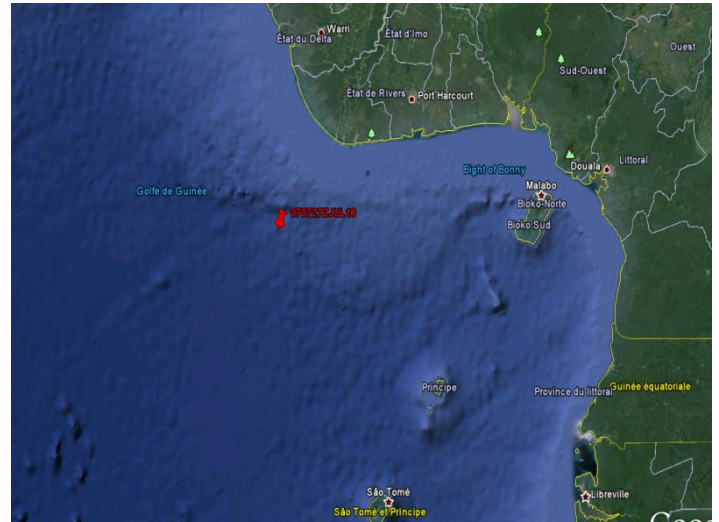
1 – Guinea: Attack against merchant vessel (09°23N / 013°41W)



On **3rd July 2016**, at about **04:50LT**, one vessel anchored south Conakry harbour had been boarded by six men, armed with guns and knives. The assailants assaulted one crew member causing injuries, and held another in hostage. Then, they opened fire, damaging the vessel's accommodation, stole cash and crew's personal belongings before quitting the vessel.

Comment: Attacks against anchored vessels seem to follow same modus operandi: several robbers, generally armed and violent, holding hostages to get cash and supplies.

2. Nigeria: Attack against tanker (03°18N / 005°11E)



On **07th July 2016**, at about **0730 UTC**, one tanker transiting from Agbami oil terminal to Brazil was attacked by armed pirates operating by means of two skiffs. All crew members sheltered in citadel. Three pirates boarded the tanker. End of the attack was reported at 1130 UTC by ship's owner. All crew members are safe. Tanker proceeds to Brazil.
